




STATE CLASS STUDENTS



The number of State Class Students grew from 75 in 1994 to more than 3,000 projected in 2021! Including the One Day Students, more than 5,000 young people were expected to attend TeenPact Leadership School State Classes in 2021.

Though some Classes will not be able to be held at their Capitol, in 2021, **for the first time, all 50 States were scheduled to host a State Class** (blue line). Some States host multiple Classes each year (red line).

COVID-19 IMPACT

In March 2020, due to COVID-19, TeenPact cancelled 32 State Classes and all Alumni Events, yet God sustained TeenPact Leadership Schools in the midst of uncertain times. During the crisis of cancelled Classes, God used you to sustain the mission of TeenPact.

In March, after reducing expenses significantly, the budget was recalculated. It was determined that \$391,000 would be needed to fill the revenue shortfall for TeenPact to survive financially until September 1, 2020, when State Class registration fees would begin to be received.

Incredibly, from March 12 to May 7, donors gave to keep TeenPact Strong. Alumni, parents, grandparents, employees, and friends wrote stories of how powerfully TeenPact had impacted your lives. By May, it became clear that TeenPact would not only survive, but would thrive.

WHY DOES TEENPACT NEED DONATIONS?

Sometimes, people ask why donations are needed since Students pay fees to attend TeenPact events. The simple answer is that the fees that Students are charged do not cover all the costs needed to produce and implement TeenPact's programs.

Volunteers, State Coordinators and their teams, Program Directors, Traveling Interns, and Student Staffers, contribute thousands of hours of free service to TeenPact each year, significantly reducing the amount of money needed to produce the programs. But even after adding Student fees plus money saved by volunteers, a gap of funding (needed to produce and implement the programs) still exists.

The donation dollars needed to fully fund the 2020/2021 budget are \$366,810. Because \$254,544 has already been given for the 2020/2021 fiscal year, the actual amount currently needed to meet the financial need for this fiscal year ending June 30, 2021, is \$112,266. (Note: based on report: 1/28/2021)

In summary, Student registration fees would cost hundreds of dollars more per Student if Volunteers and Donors did not give their time and money to support TeenPact. Volunteers and Donors make TeenPact possible for thousands of Students each year!




