Greetings to you!

The 2023 season has been another exciting year of increase. This year, we have conducted more classes for more students in more locations than ever before. A total of 6,473 students (aged 8 to 19) attended a State Class, representing a 17.7% increase from the previous year.

Because of your donations, TeenPact was financially able to meet the growing demand of student numbers in 2023. *Thank you for your sacrificial investment in these young lives!*

The number of State Classes is increasing again, from 63 in 2023 to 70 in 2024 due to the abundant interest in many states.

With the trajectory set for expansion, 2023/2024 is also a year of historic transition as TeenPact welcomes the third CEO in its 30 year history. Founder Tim Echols passed the baton to me at National Convention in 2010, and I now have the wonderful opportunity to pass the mantle of leadership to Chris May, who has been prayerfully and carefully selected to serve as the next CEO. I, along with the Board of Directors, have the highest confidence that Chris is well-prepared to lead with excellence and carry forward the vision of Changing Lives to Change the World!

I am incredibly grateful to you for your investment in TeenPact's mission to train and disciple the next generation of servant leaders. 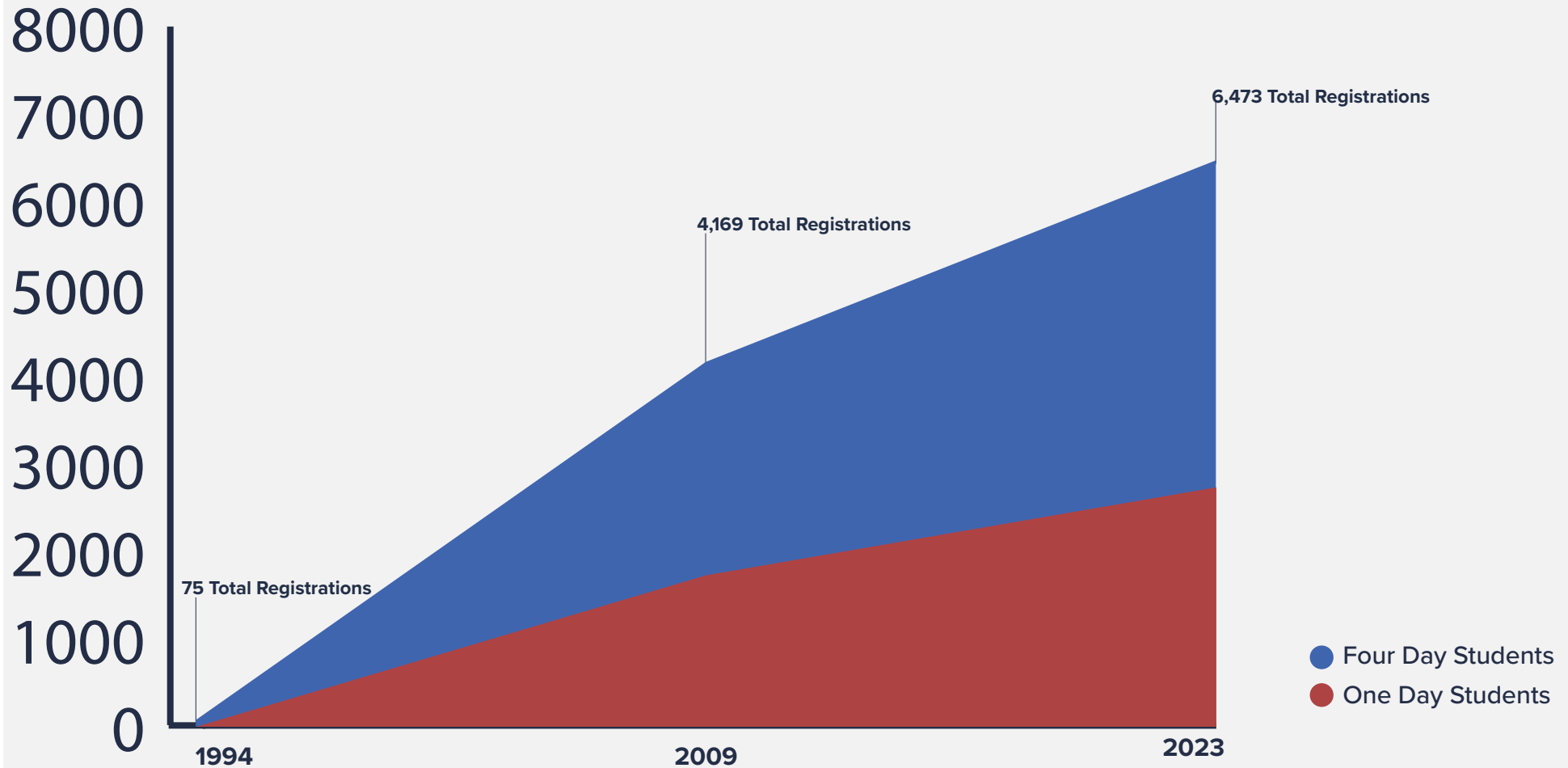

WHY DOES TEENPACT NEED DONATIONS?

Why are donations needed since students pay fees to attend TeenPact events?

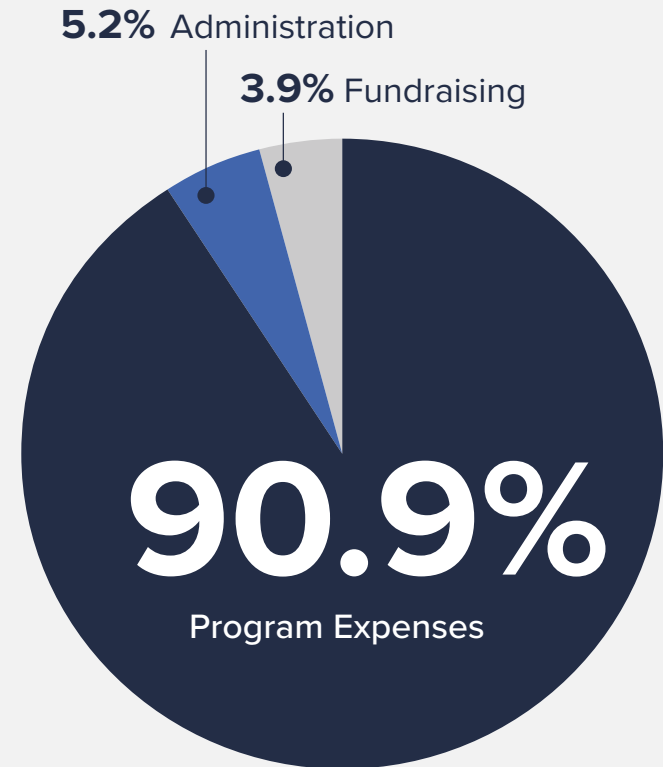
The simple answer is that the fees students are charged do not cover all the costs needed to produce and implement TeenPact's programs.

Volunteers, State Coordinators and their teams, Program Directors, traveling interns, and student staffers, contribute thousands of hours of free service to TeenPact each year, significantly reducing the amount of money needed to produce the programs.

But even after adding student fees plus money saved by volunteers, a gap of funding needed to produce and implement the programs still exists.

Donations of \$455,000 are needed to fully fund the 2023/2024 budget for the 2024 State Class Season.

In summary, student registration fees would cost hundreds of dollars more per student if volunteers and donors did not give their time and money to support TeenPact. TeenPact supporters make high quality, effective leadership and discipleship training possible for thousands of students each year!

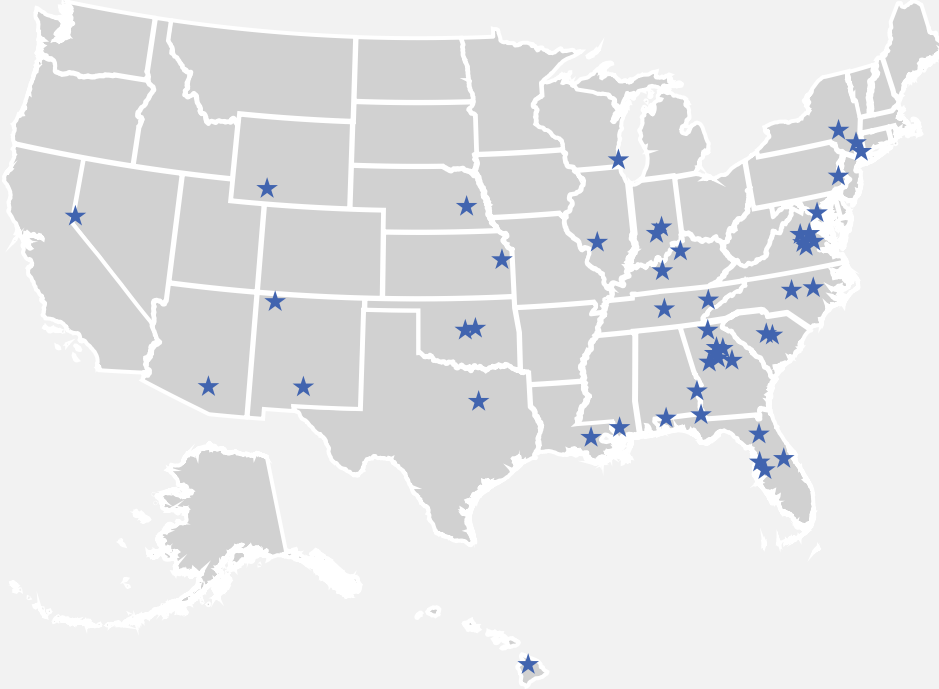
