TeenPact will honor donor intentions, with the following disclaimer: Our Restricted Donation policy ensures that all gifts designated for a specific project are applied to that project, with the understanding that State Classes cannot exist without carefully developed programs and leaders. In instances where contributions for a particular project exceed what can be wisely applied to that need, or if the designated purpose becomes impracticable, we will reallocate those funds to related purposes that align closely with the donor's original intent and best support the overall mission and programmatic needs of TeenPact. This ensures that we maintain the flexibility necessary to adapt and respond to emerging priorities while respecting donor intent.

We ensure excellence. For donations generated for a restricted fund, such as a specific State Class, 10% of the funds will accrue to the TeenPact General Fund. This amount helps to offset the expenses of producing and hosting the programs, as well as helps to cover the overall processing of funds, including depositing and accounting of donations, year-end acknowledgments, creating invoices, processing scholarship requests, and other necessary administrative tasks.

We maintain the highest standards. It is our commitment to uphold the highest standards of stewardship and accountability, in accordance with ECFA's Standards and the Donor Bill of Rights, ensuring that your gift has the maximum impact in achieving our shared mission of influencing young people to follow Christ and engage the culture in His name. Contributions for a specific student are not considered eligible for a tax deduction by the IRS.
